## *A message from our Local President*

Dear Members,



The warm weather is here and so are some of the busiest months for the employees here in the Town of Oyster Bay. Members are working diligently on the parks, beaches, mowing, paving and getting ready for all the Summer Programs. Due to this, there may be opportunities for overtime. Remember that it is your choice on how you want to receive your overtime. It can be at the overtime rate of pay or compensatory time off, both equalling time and one half (section 5-4.0 of CBA).

Good news for members that are Tier 5 and Tier 6 in the NYS Retirement System. There was another victory for the “Fix Tier 6” campaign when the State of New York passed the budget. For all members in Tier 5 and Tier 6, their final average salary will be based on three years, no longer five. This is important because it will increase your pension rate. Also, for the next two years, overtime earnings will be excluded from the pension contribution rate. This means that any overtime earned will not be used towards your payments to the retirement system.

The Region One golf outing was held on May 13 at Eisenhower Park. Our Member Appreciation winners had a great day of golfing despite the weather. The fun continued during dinner as Planning and Developments’ Lara Bousleiman won the big prize, a 70" Samsung TV, from the raffle. Photos from the event can be seen on the back.

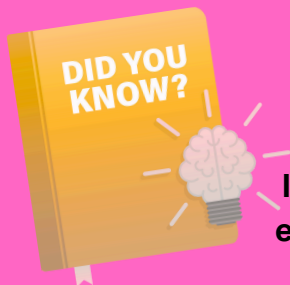

**CIVIL SERVICE TEST NOTIFICATION**

If you are interested in taking Civil Service exams, you can sign up for announcements for titles that you qualify for. Here's how:

- Visit [www.nassaucivilservice.com](http://www.nassaucivilservice.com)
- Click on job interest/job description located in the menu on the left of the screen
- You can use the search feature to find specific titles
- When you find the title you are interested in, click on the title (make sure it says "Town" next to title)
- Click the Subscribe button
- Enter your information and click submit

By doing this, you will get the announcement sent to you as soon as it is available. However, just because the test announcement has been released, it does not automatically mean that the Town of Oyster Bay will be hiring for this title.

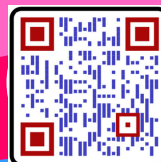
