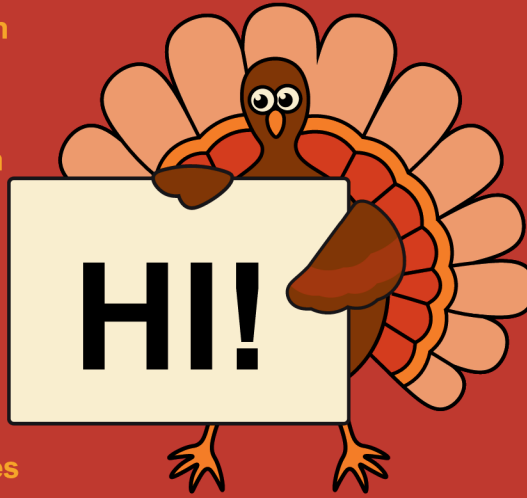

DON'T FORGET

Please remember to use your vacation time. Take note of section 7-1.1, which explains how many days you will earn in 2026 based on your years of employment. These days plus the time you carry over can not exceed 60 days, section 7-1.1.4. If they do, you will not receive those days once the 60 day cap is reached.

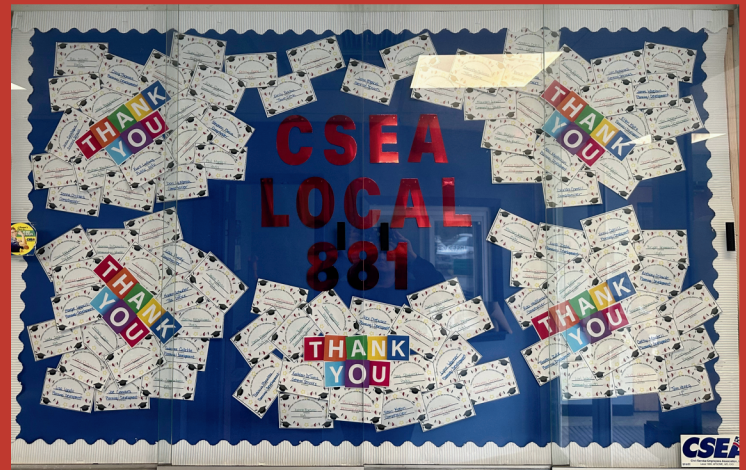
EXAMPLE

	<u>CURRENT TIME</u>	<u>2026 EARNED*</u>	<u>TOTAL DAYS</u>
Emp. A	53 DAYS	17 DAYS	70 DAYS
Emp. B	43 DAYS	17 DAYS	60 DAYS

Employee A will not earn their full 17 days. They will only earn 7 days due to vacation time carry-over.
