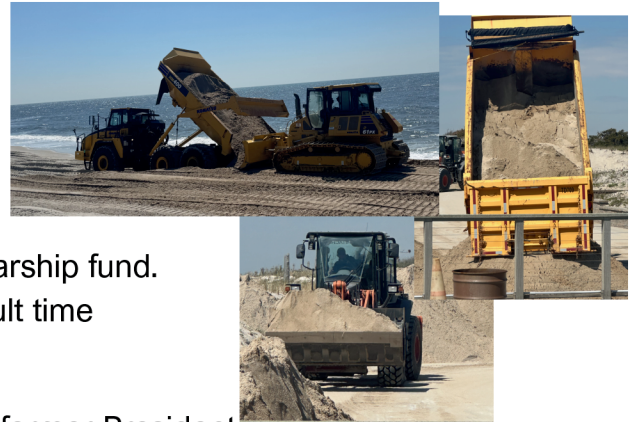
## *A message from our Local President*
