This law signed by President George H.W. Bush on July 26, 1990, prohibits discrimination against those with disabilities in all areas of employment and public services.

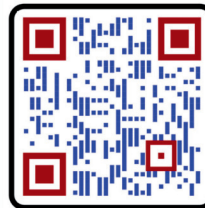
